Application and Enrollment Procedures

International Student Application Checklist

The following items must be submitted before a student can be given a final acceptance and be issued an I-20.

- _____ 1. *Complete Application for Enrollment form (2 pages)
- _____ 2. *Complete Registration Form (2 pages)
- _____ 3. Color copy of Passport information page
- _____ 4. **Copy of Birth Certificate
- _____ 5. **School Transcripts or Grade Reports (at least 3 years)
- _____ 6. **Proof of Immunization (required by the State of California)
- _____ 7. Two Recommendation forms completed by former teachers, school administrators, and/or persons of authority (church leader, sports coach, etc.)
- _____ 8. Student Interview: In person or by video call (Skype, etc.)
- _____ 9. Student Essay: Answer three questions in essay form.
- _____ 10. Bank Statement(s) from parents, student, or guardians. Must show proof of funds for the mandatory annual fees plus ten months of housing (\$10,000). Documents should include the US Dollar amount of up to \$22,000 for 9th-12th.
- _____ 11. ***Color copy of Student Visa and current I-20

If applying online, email pdf or jpg files to i20@bethelwarriors.org.

The application review process can take from one to two weeks to complete in order to issue an I-20.

Foreign students who are accepted will receive a pdf version of the Acceptance Letter and unsigned I-20 by email. The original signed I-20 and Acceptance Letter will be mailed to the foreign address provided on the Application for Enrollment form unless an alternate address is requested. Delivery to foreign countries typically takes two weeks.

Transfer students who are accepted will receive an Acceptance Letter that includes the I-20 transfer request. This letter contains Bethel's SEVIS School Code and should be given to the current school.
